

CAMP HILL BOYS – TOP A LEVEL SCHOOL IN THE MIDLANDS !

A Level Results:

It was another record breaking year with a staggering **35.2%** of A Levels (excluding General Studies) being passed at A* grade, **77.9%** at A*/A and **93.6%** A*/B. Some 76 pupils achieved at least one A* grade. Twelve students achieved three A* grades, nine achieved 4A* grades and four (Samuel, Childs, Rowan May, Robert McDonald and Mohammad Samad) achieved 5A* grades. One student, Xiaoyuan Li, achieved an astonishing 5A* and one A grade.

69 students achieved straight A*/A grades at A Level (excluding General Studies). 107 boys achieved at least ABB grades excluding General Studies (these are the grades needed this year to allow students to 'trade-up' their offers). Thirteen students receiving offers achieved entry into Oxford. 93 students achieved entry into their first choice university and 7 into their second choice university.

The school's results place it **extremely high** in the league table of results published by the Times for State Schools (**second** for percentage A* grades and **sixth** for percentage A* to B grades).

AS Results:

After achieving excellent GCSE results in 2012, there were, of course, a large number of outstanding performances:

- Thomas Chalklen, Torin Elmhirst, Anthony Featherstone, Joshua Lee, Ali Nathani, Luka Novovic, Jaskaran Rajput, Charlie Song, Robert Walters and Terence Wu all achieved 5 A grades at AS and an A* in A Level Mathematics.
- Stephen Chiu, Lewis Hedges and Toby Saunders achieved 5 A grades at AS and an A in A Level Mathematics.
- Ali Alam, Kieran Bakhtiari, Samuel Cartmill, , Hok Yin, Cameron Kigonya, , Oliver Lester, Arjan Nagra, , Kishan Pankhania, Jamil Shah Foridi, Henry Smart, , Arjun Varma, George Wager, James Walker, , Fraser West, all achieved 5 A grades at AS.
- Benedict Blayney, Chun Wai Cheung, Vinul Denagama Witharanage, Andrew Hawkin and David Watson all achieved 4 A grades at AS Level and an A* grade in Mathematics at A Level.
- Alessandro Barwani-Rai, Alexander Gray, Matthew Jeffs and Daniel Mladenovic all achieved 4 A grades at AS Level and an A grade at A Level Mathematics.

Some 73 students achieved at least 3 A grades, 51 at least 4 A grades and 26 at least 5 A grades at AS Level or above.

GCSE Results:

This year achieved another excellent set of GCSE results. **85.7%** of all GCSE's were at A*/A grades and an impressive **55.3%** were at A* grade.

One student (Gaspard Bilso) achieved 11 A* grades and nine students (Amir Ahmed, Joe Cullen, Joe Khalique-Brown, Jordan McDonagh, Giles Moss, Oliver Paulin, Aatif Syed, Peter Watson and Faaris Zaki) achieved 10 A* straight grades. Eight students achieved 9 A* grades and eight achieved 8A* grades. Forty seven out of a year group of ninety three achieved straight A*/A grades. 87 students achieved at least 5A*/A grades.

The school was prominent, once again in the league tables for State Schools of the Times Newspaper (**sixth** for percentage A* grades and **eleventh** for percentage A*/A grades).
