

Exam Results 2016 – Congratulations to all!

At A Level, nearly a third (31%) of all exams taken were passed at A* grade – according to The Times, only two boys' state schools did better

At A Level, one boy achieved 6 A* grades and an EPQ so extraordinarily good that the external moderator said it gave him a feeling of 'utter euphoria'!

At A Level, 10 boys achieved at least 4 A* grades

24 boys went on to study medicine – the most ever qualifying for this highly demanding course

At GCSE, nearly two-thirds (63%) of all exams taken were passed at grade A* - according to The Times, that put us at number one among boys' state schools (how did those two girls' schools do it?)

At GCSE, 9 out of 10 of all exams taken were passed at grade A or above

At GCSE, 9 boys gained 10 A* grades; 2 of those actually gained 11
