SUMMARY OF INSTRUCTIONS

You are on study leave from **Monday 6th to Friday 17th January 2025**. You only need to attend school when you have an exam. It is a privilege given to you and will be taken away from you if you misbehave during this period or if staff deem it appropriate leading up to the mocks. It is your responsibility to make sure that you attend your exams and that you are on time. Please speak to a member of the school office staff (0121 444 3188) if you are unable to attend due to health issues, or if you will be late due to unforeseen circumstances. If you are late then wait at reception and you will be escorted into your exam room. Do not enter an exam room by yourself. You may wish to email Mrs Simmonite, as well, but she will be unable to pick them up first thing in the morning.

All morning exams start at 9.00am, except for the Biology essay on 16th January which will start at 9.15am.
P2-3 and P4-5 exams start at the beginning of normal period times.

All exams take place in the rooms stated. Please make sure you look at your own individual timetable or the seating plans (exam notice board - adjacent to R5) to know where you are sitting for each exam. You will not always be in the same room or seat.

Make sure you bring your own stationery - none will be provided. You must write in **BLACK INK and not BLUE INK**.

It is essential that you are outside your designated room **10 mins before the start of your exam**. **Five minutes before an exam starts a briefing will take place where the necessary instructions will be given. If you attempt to enter the room after this briefing has started, you will be prevented from doing so. The exam will start without you. You will then be given the briefing outside the exam room and only then be allowed to enter the room. Thus, you will lose exam time.**

Wear school full regulation uniform. No mobile phones, electronic devices, bags, watches or any smart devices will be allowed into any of the rooms.
If you are found in possession of a mobile phone, electronic device, watch or smart devices in an exam room you will be given a zero for that exam.

If you are found cheating you will be given a zero for that exam.

PLEASE NOTE

**If you have a clash of exams you will be supervised in between your two exams.
You will be able to revise using books but you will not be able to use your mobile or any form of electronics.**
