Dear Prospective Sixth Former,

King Edward VI Camp Hill School for Boys welcomes your interest in joining our Sixth Form. As one of the city's King Edward VI Grammar schools we are pleased to accept a number of candidates from other local schools each year. Our current Sixth Form numbers are around 340, which includes students from a variety of local comprehensive, grammar and independent schools, as well as students who joined us in Year 7. Camp Hill has always prided itself on the diversity of its social and ethnic composition.

There is an A Level Options Evening on Thursday 6th November 2025, for any student (and their parent or carer) considering applying to join the Sixth Form in September 2026. More information will be on the school website closer to the time. The application form will be on the website shortly after this date, and applications will close in February 2026. Departmental videos are available for most subjects on the website under *Sixth Form Open Evening*.

Depending on resources, subject availability and demand, Camp Hill expects to admit about 190 students into Year 12 next year. A minimum of 40 external admissions are anticipated each year at age 16 years for entry into Year 12; but we hope to welcome more external admissions than this number. Admission is based upon the predicted grades provided by the applicant's school.

To achieve entry into the Sixth Form in September 2026, prospective entrants (both existing pupils and external candidates) must achieve:

- at least 54 points in a student's best six GCSE subjects plus GCSE Mathematics and English Language (Best 8), where a Grade 9 is 9 points, Grade 8 is 8 points, and so on
- at least a grade 5 in English Language, and a grade 6 in Mathematics
- at least a grade 7 at GCSE in those subjects they wish to study at A Level (or in a similar subject if that subject is not studied at GCSE, e.g., GCSE History for A level Politics)
- at least a grade 8 at GCSE in Mathematics to study Further Maths

Offers of places in the Sixth Form will be conditional on achievement of these results and capacity of chosen courses. In the event of over-subscription, priority will be given to 'looked after or previously looked after children' who meet the admissions criteria, students who attract Pupil Premium who meet the admissions criteria (up to 25% of the external intake), and those with the highest predicted GCSE scores (overall and then within their chosen A level subjects). In the case of a tie then priority will be given to those living in closest proximity to the school.
